

# Miss Jenni Shawl

## A luscious Feather and Fan Shawl

*Designed by Nancy Ricci, writer of the blog Getting Purly With It*

**Materials:** 2 balls of Kidsilk Haze by Rowan and 2 balls of Lace Merino Silk by Karabella  
**Needle size:** circ. 24" US 8 and US9 straight to bind off  
**Gauge:** 16 stitches over 4 " in st st

### **Directions**

#### **Step1:**

With one strand of Kidsilk Haze and one strand of Lace Merino Silk held together, cast on 56 stitches.

Row 1: knit

Row 2: knit

Row 3 (RS): knit

Row 4 (WS): k1, p to last stitch, k1

Row5: k1, \* (k2tog) 3 times, (yo, k1) 6 times, (k2tog) 3 times.

Repeat from \* to last st in row, k1

Row 6: knit

#### **Step 2:**

Now begins the actual pattern!

Row 7 (RS): knit

Row 8 (WS): k1, purl to last st, k1

Row 9: k1, \*(k2tog) 3 times, (yo, k1) 6 times, (k2tog) 3 times.

Repeat from \* to last st in row, k1

Row 10: knit

Row 11: knit

Row12: k1, p to last st, k1

Row 13: knit

Row 14: k1, p to last st, k1

Row 15: k1, \*(k2tog) 3 times, (yo, k1) 6 times, (k2tog) 3 times,

Repeat from \* to last st in row, k1

Row 16: knit

Repeat row 7 to row 16 until you run out of yarn.

***However, make sure your last row follows the st pattern of row 8!***

**Step 3:**

Your first piece is now done! Without casting off, put it aside and transfer it onto a needle holder.

Now you are going to knit an identical piece with the other 2 balls left.

**Step 4:**

You have finished two identical pieces and have ended both pieces with a row 8. You are now going to apply the three needle bind off to connect those two identical pieces together.

- With RS of two pieces hold together, apply three needle bind off.

- Weave in all ends. Block your shawl if desired.

All done! Enjoy!
