Snug Cabled Fingerless Gloves

Materials

Yarn: Artyarn beaded silk, Misti Alpaca dk, Debbie bliss pure silk, Debbie Bliss Alpaca/silk dk. Any dk yarn will do as long as you have about 100 yard of yarn. Sportweight will do too but the glove will be a tiny bit bigger.

Needle Size 5 or size to obtain gauge! I am a very tight knitter so you might want to consider a different needle size!

Darning needle for seaming

Gauge:

6 st and 8 rows in = 1" in St st

Be sure to check your gauge, okay?

Size: Length: approx. 6"

Width (when not seamed): approx. 5"

Directions

Step 1:

Cast on 40 sts. Make sure you have about 15" tail (for the seaming later on)

Start with 6 rows of k1, p1 ribbing.

STEP 2:

Now the Plaited Cable fun can begin!

LEFT HAND GLOVE

- 1) (RS) k9, p2, k9, p2, k18
- 2) (WS) p18, k2, p9, k2, p9 (or in other words knit the knits and purl the purls)
- 3) K9, p2, sl next 3 st on cable needle and leave at back. Now k3, then k3 from cable needle, k3, p2, k18
- 4) Knit the knits and purl the purls
- 5) Repeat row 1
- 6) Repeat row 2
- 7) K9, p2, k3, sl next 3 st on cable needle and leave at front. Now k3, then k3 from cable needle, p2, k18
- 8) Knit the knits and purl the purls

There you have it. These 8 rows form the pattern.

Now repeat these 8 rows four times more, **however in your very last repeat simply omit row 7) and 8).** In the end you should have 5 plaited cables in your glove.

STEP 3:

Almost there !

Start 4 rows of k1 p1 ribbing and bind off in ribbing pattern. Bind off loosely!

STEP 4:

Seam that glove!

The base of your glove are the first 6 ribbed rows, the top of your glove are the 4 ribbed rows.

Start seaming down from the the top for about 1 3/4 inches. Weave in the ends.
Now with the tail end at the bottom of the glove, start seaming up for about 4 inches.
Weave in ends.

If all went well, you should have an opening for your thumb that is about 1 1/4 inches wide.

It is all up to you where and how big exactly you want that thumb opening to be.

Now start on your Right Hand Glove! Step 1, 3 and 4 remain the same, step 2 you do as follows:

- 1) (RS) k18, p2, k9, p2, k9
- 2) (WS) p9, k2, p9, k2, p18 (or in other words knit the knits and purl the purls)
- 3) K18, p2, sl next 3 st on cable needle and leave at back. Now k3, then k3 from cable needle, k3, p2, k9
- 4) Knit the knits and purl the purls
- 5) Repeat row 1
- 6) Repeat row 2
- 7) K18, p2, k3, sl next 3 st on cable needle and leave at front. Now k3, then k3 from cable needle, p2, k9
- 8) Knit the knits and purl the purls

There you have it. These 8 rows form the pattern.

Now repeat these 8 rows four times more, **however in your very last repeat simply omit row 7) and 8).** In the end you should have 5 plaited cables in your glove.
