

# Nettie Hat Version 1

In the round easy stockinette stitch hat

**Materials:** 140 yards of light worsted weight or heavy dk yarn  
**Needle size:** US 5 and US 7 16" circular needle  
**Gauge:** 18 stitches over 4" in stockinette stitch using larger needles

Abbreviations:

K: knit

P: purl

K2tog: knit two together

## **Directions**

Cast on 90 stitches

### **Step 1:**

With smaller circular needles, CO 90 sts.

Join to work in the round and knit every round until your piece measures 3.5 inches from CO edge.

### **Step 2:**

Change to bigger needles and knit every round until your piece measures 8 inches from CO edge.

**Step 3: Decreasing for the top**

Rnd 1: \*K8, k2tog. Repeat from \* to end of rnd.

Rnd 2: K to end of rnd.

Rnd 3: \*K7, k2tog. Repeat from \* to end of rnd.

Rnd 4: K to end of rnd.

Rnd 5: \*K6, k2tog. Repeat from \* to end of rnd.

Rnd 6: K to end of rnd.

Rnd 7: \*K5, k2tog. Repeat from \* to end of rnd.

Rnd 8: K to end of rnd.

Rnd 9: \*K4, k2tog. Repeat from \* to end of rnd.

Rnd 10: K to end of rnd.

Rnd 11: \*K3, k2tog. Repeat from \* to end of rnd.

Rnd 12: K to end of rnd.

Rnd 13: \*K2, k2tog. Repeat from \* to end of rnd.

Rnd 14: K to end of rnd.

Rnd 15: K1, k2tog. Repeat from \* to end of rnd.

Rnd 16: K2tog to end of rnd.

**Step 5:**

Cut yarn, leaving a 8" tail. Thread onto darning needle, run through the remaining sts and fasten off.

Weave in ends.
